Growing Deep and Wide

Since moving into our current facility in 2015, God has been growing the Hope Waukee community deep (in our love for one another and God) and wide (in the amount of children, students, and adults attending worship and groups).

- In the past year, **weekly worship attendance** has grown from an average of 435 to 624, an **increase of 30%**.
- Since 2021, our **HopeKids ministry** for three year-old through grade 5 has increased from 75 each weekend to over 155 children each weekend, and **increase of 51%**.
- Since 2021, our **Hope Waukee Preschool** has grown from 107 children to over 130 today.
- Since 2021, over 215 people have been baptized into new life in Christ.

- This past summer, **1260 kids** experienced God's love at **Vacation Bible School!**
- This Fall, over 80 adults are participating in the **Alpha course** with close to 60 women participating in **women's ministry** groups and classes.

Current Facility Updates

Thanks to your continued generous giving, in the past year we've been able to accomplish several larger projects and additions to our facility and grounds!

- A newly painted atrium with a fresh look for weekly programming, community events, and weddings.
- Newly **painted classrooms** that are used for preschool, HopeKids ministry, student small groups and adult classes.
- Updated, energy-efficient lighting to the atrium and Crossway space to save on utility costs and provide excellence in weekly programming.
- A new, lighted, outdoor cross and patio space to grace the southeast side of our property (coming soon!).

Building for the Future

Q. What is the focus of the Building Hope for Tomorrow campaign?

A. Freeing us up as a congregation to dream and plan for an exciting future of building growth and renovation! Why? We're surrounded by growth!

Population Growth!

First, Waukee is now the fastest growing city in Iowa! This brings incredible potential over the next decade to reach thousands of new residents for Christ in Waukee and the surrounding area. We want to be ready to expand our capacity in spiritual maturity and physical space to meet the growing needs around us.

Church Growth!

Secondly, Hope Waukee is a healthy, growing, thriving congregation, and because of that, we want our facility to keep up with our growing mission! Worship attendance has increased by over 30% in the past year. Over 700 students join us on Wednesday nights, maxing out our building capacity. We've become a true community center all throughout the year hosting and partnering with community groups and gatherings. In addition to our numerical growth, our facility, (originally completed in 2007), needs multiple upgrades including lighting, HVAC, and kitchen infrastructure.

Future Expansion!

Finally, we believe God is leading Hope Waukee to consider future expansion of the facility including a new worship center and additional classrooms and gathering spaces.

The Time is Now!

Given these realities, our focus now is a one-year debtreduction campaign. Hope Waukee current has approximately \$2,900,000 of debt from our building purchase and renovations. Church leadership determined a healthy level of debt during the original purchase and renovation of our current facility, and thanks to your generosity, we have been faithfully paying down that amount for the past several years. However, making an increased, intentional, all-church effort to pay off our debt will not only save us approximately \$60,000 in annual interest, but set us up to start planning for future building renovations and expansion.

Let's Prepare for the Future!

Our current interest rate of 2.7% is locked in until 2026. At that time, interest rates are projected to increase to 5-7%, significantly increasing our annual interest payments. Paying down our debt now will not only save us thousands of dollars that could be spent on ministry and mission, but free us up to pay more upfront or take on new debt (if needed) for future expansion of our facility!

Building Hope for Tomorrow: Campaign Goals

Larger than meeting financial goals, our ultimate goal of this campaign is the further discipleship of Hope Waukee in our understanding of Biblical stewardship. With the projected general fund deficit of Hope Waukee (\$90,000.00 for the current fiscal year), we see the campaign as an opportunity to directly impact the joy-filled, generous giving of

1. GATHER | Weekly Worship

Why? Why? **Liberation:** Find freedom in guilt-free, pressure-free giving; not under compulsion, but cheerfully, generously, and freely!


How? Understand that everything we have belongs to God.

Discover the Joy of Cheerful Giving: Try These Steps

Step One | Pray

Ask God this question: "Lord, what do you want to do through me to accomplish your will for Hope Waukee?"

"Keep on asking, and you will be given what you ask for. Keep on looking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened." Matthew 7:7

Step Two | Listen to God

Keep asking until you "hear" God's answer. If you don't get anything – in other words, if you don't get a pretty strong indication in your heart, soul or mind as you pray each day throughout this campaign – then quiet your life until you can. Be still. Listen to God, not people. God will write a number on your heart, soul or mind.

Step Three | Take a Leap of Faith

Trust God enough to do whatever he calls you to do, believing that he will provide the means to make it happen (2 Corinthians 9:6-11).
